

Instructor Certification Guidelines

Great Expectations extends instructor certification to a select group of highly qualified individuals. In order to become a certified Great Expectations instructor, interested parties should submit an intern application and video presentation to the Great Expectations office for selection by a review committee. **Interested parties must show successful classroom implementation of the Great Expectations methodology, which includes the 17 classroom practices.** Potential new instructors will also take part in additional training.

TIMELINE

- *Application and Video – postmarked no later than January 31, 2019

- *Initial Instructor Training – March 30, 2019, at UCO in Edmond (attendance is **STRONGLY** recommended)

- *Additional Training Days – June 10-14 at Owasso High School (Mandatory)

- *Intern Service Week (**Locations are tentative**)
 - June 24-28, 2019 – Edmond
 - July 8-12, 2019 – Edmond & Claremore
 - July 15-19, 2019 – Enid, Lawton & Michigan
 - July 22-26, 2019 – Tomball TX
 - July 29- August 2, 2019 – Bixby

The GE CEO will choose one of the above weeks and a location for the applicant to complete intern service.

COST AND BENEFITS OF COMMITMENT

*The intern will be paid \$500 minus retirement and taxes for teaching during the intern service week. Hotel lodging, some meals, and an \$80 Walmart Card for supplies will be provided.

A certified instructor - working with a partner - will be paid \$950 per week for teaching methodology. Retirement and taxes will be withheld. Hotel lodging, some meals, and \$80 Walmart Card for supplies will be provided.
