We looked at the options and collectively decided on which to implement. The students were fully engaged in the introduction process and really got into identifying potential behavioral goals. I couldn't have been more pleased when they chose to address coming into class and getting to work. Students coming in late also had to be addressed - a good thing! To be able to remind them that this procedure was one that was chosen by the class has made a huge difference. It wasn't a teacher-made rule! I am finding that the atmosphere at the beginning is towards being productive from the start. It's also making me have everything ready for them and I find I've gotten more creative in how I begin the class. I also have asked students for ideas.
