We will use the life principles. We will be our best!

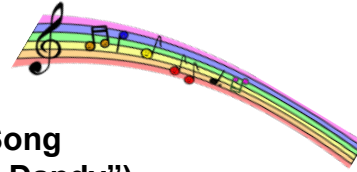
