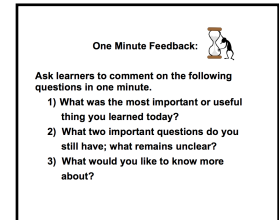

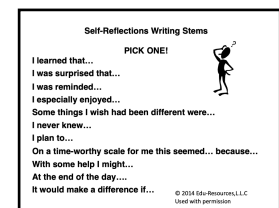
3. [Choice and Goal Progress Sheets](#) - For assessing progress in achieving goals.

There are three forms for goal setting and three forms for Choice:

- Quick individual progress sheet - This has 3 progress sheets to a page that may be cut apart for use with multiple students for a quick evaluation.
 - Multiple individual evaluations - This sheet may be used by an individual student to make 3 progress evaluations for a single choice/goal.
 - Goal Progress Worksheet - This allows for a more detailed evaluation of choice/goal progress giving opportunities/options and benefits/obstacles.
